- 66. Have a garage sale or donate all unwanted/unneeded items in house, basement, garage etc.
- 67. Clean the trashcans to eliminate any unpleasant smell
- 68. Make sure the space is brightly lit
- 69. Sweep the garage floor
- 70. Clean any oil and rust stains from the floor
- 71. Clean the windows
- 72. Replace any cracked or broken window glass
- 73. Get rid of cobwebs
- 74. The garage door is easy to maneuver up and down
- 75. Pile up storage or tubs in one corner
- 76. Remove all recycling that may be piling up
- 77. Hang bicycles on bicycle hooks (or store in an off-site storage unit if available – or friends house)
